

## Manager's Report



Welcome Back Everyone!!

Hoping everyone had a great summer??? Hard to believe that we will be starting our favorite winter pastime in only a few weeks. All leagues will begin on Monday September 30. Make sure you contact your league representatives and get signed up early. Just to update all of you on what's been happening at the rink this spring and summer. This year was definitely a little quieter on the number of projects taken on and it is now time to save a little money for the future. We did a small renovation in the office and expanded the Pro Shop to better serve our members with all their curling equipment and attire. Check it out....there are some new fun novelty items that will provide some great gift or prize opportunities. The ice surface floor received another coat of sealant and this should help with being able to rent this area without ruining the surface. The clean up this past season went well and this should even make it better. The Gas City Rollers used the facility over the off season and we are looking at adding the Floor Shuffleboard next season. The compressor in back end received a rebuild this year and some changes to the brine lines and header were completed. This was all done for about \$10K but a necessary evil to keep things running smooth and be able to keep making great ice. In trying to balance the budget the Board has decided to raise the building levy to \$35.00 this season. Hopefully the original \$25.00 will cover the cost of the City Loan and the extra \$10.00 can go to cover extra building costs like the compressor and help provide a little extra for a building fund that will be used to help match future grant applications. Mark will also have a new toy this season. At the end of the year we purchased a new scraper. The old one was beginning to show signs of wear and was needing a few new parts and batteries. The Senior Club had voted to generously donate some funds to the club and we were hoping these funds could be put towards the purchase of the scraper.

We are pleased to have Sammy Cheung of Sammy's Little India returning to our establishment this season. Sammy is eager to provide a terrific food service to our members and banquet functions. She will be offering her western menu as well as a couple of her famous Indian dishes. She will be open from 11-7 Monday through Friday and during special events. Coffee service from 9-11am. Please support her and if you are looking for extra catering needs, please keep her in mind.

Mark will be returning as head ice technician this season. The ice plant will be turned on September 18 with install beginning Sept 20th and with the help of his boys, I know we should have great ice all season. With the updates in the back end we are hoping that everything will be in good working condition. Lounge staff Misty Ross and Tanis Stadnyk (expecting a baby in October) will be providing our members with their great service once again and we plan to implement some specials and fun events to make your lounge experience pleasurable. Misty will have a couple helpers to serve while Tanis is off on maternity leave. Misty will be helping me out in the office position. Looks like it will be another fantastic year with great staff in place.

Our club will be hosting the U15 Provincial Qualifier March 13-15, 2020. This is the only extra event that we will have this year. Check out the Events Calendar for a list of events and bonspiels for the season.
